



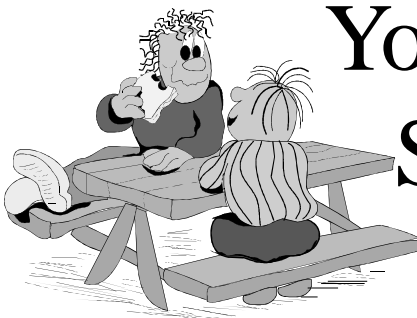

Schwaben AC Tournament Rules

Length of games: Both Men's and O-30 games will be 2 x 15 minutes without intermission, just switch sides at half time. Final games will be 2 x 20 minutes. We reserve the right to change the length of the games due to weather conditions. Games are to start on time without delay! Referees are instructed to wait only 15 minutes if a team is late, then the game is forfeited. Visiting team chooses side at the start of the game.

Players: 11 Players per side, roster of 18 for the tournament. Players must be registered with their participating team. Using an unregistered player is cause for forfeit, with a 3:0 score for the opponent. If the opposing team wins by a higher score, the higher score will stand. Each team is allowed to sign 4 secondary players with a valid club ID pass.

Points: 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, 0 points for a loss.

Tiebreaker:

1. Goal Differential
2. Most goals scored
3. Penalty kicks

Offsides: Games shall be played **WITHOUT** offside rule in effect!

Red Cards: A player receiving a red card shall be banned from the next tournament game. Two yellow cards in the same game carry the same penalty. Single yellow card will not carry over to the next game.

Team Groupings: Teams will be divided into two groups. The winner of each group will play in the final game.

Final Game: 2 x 20 minutes, in the case of a tie an overtime period of 2 x 10 minutes. If still tied, the games shall be decided by penalty kicks according to FIFA rules.

Note: We reserve the right to deny participation in the tournament if a traveling team has not submitted their state permit.
